

Results of 2025 NCCU Presidential Reappointment Approving Vote

The results of the NCCU presidential reappointment approving vote have been announced. President Tsai-Yen Li received more than 76% approval from 841 eligible voters and will be reappointed as President of NCCU. President Li's current term will end on July 31, 2026, and his new term will run from August 1, 2026, to July 31, 2030.

In order to organize the process of the university president reappointment, in accordance with the University Organization Charter, seven members were elected to form the Presidential Reappointment Committee (the Committee), at the 235th University Council meeting on August 29, 2025.

The Committee held its first meeting on September 26, 2025, and received the "Presidential Reappointment Evaluation Report" from the Ministry of Education on the same day. The Committee immediately began the preparations to ensure that the reappointment vote would be conducted within one month, as required by the Charter.

The presidential reappointment approval vote was conducted from Friday, October 17 to Thursday, October 23, 2025, between 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.. There are 841 eligible voters, including 641 full-time faculty members at the rank of lecturer or above, 10 full-time technical staff members, 43 full-time contract-based teaching staff, 8 exchange faculty members, 13 full-time research fellows, 42 representatives of administrative staff and 84 representatives of students.

Of the 841 eligible voters, 83.23 percent participated in the vote. A total of 643 ballots were approval, 48 were disapproval, 9 were invalid, 141 were unclaimed. The approval votes accounted for 76.46 percent of all eligible voters, exceeding the majority threshold stipulated in Article 15-1 of the University Organization Charter (Note: With 841 eligible voters, the threshold for approval is 421 approval votes.) . Accordingly, it is confirmed that incumbent President Li will be reappointed as President of NCCU.

The presidential reappointment approval vote has been successfully completed. The NCCU will then submit President Li's reappointment to the Ministry of Education for approval as the next president of the University.
