National Chengchi University (NCCU) was founded in 1927 in Nanjing, China and relocated to Taipei, Taiwan in 1954. Featured Programs for International Students



The departments and degree programs at the University are categorized into two types, based on the language of instruction: Chinese-taught and English-taught programs (including programs that offer sufficient English-taught courses to fulfill graduation requirements).

Most degree programs at NCCU are open to international students, with the following being the most popular among them.



International College of Innovation

The first international program in Taiwan to learn through a problem-oriented, interdisciplinary curriculum that builds upon the fields of Globalization & Democratic Governance, Asian Society & Sustainable Development, and Innovation Management and Data Science.



International Master's Program of Applied Economics and Social Development

Emphasizes three features including big data analysis, applied economics, and social development, and offers rigorous training for a strong foundation in economics and policy to enable the production of research and analysis.



International Master's Program in International Studies

A broad interdisciplinary focus on the understanding and study of contemporary international relations.



Master's Program in Global Communication and Innovation Technology

The first international and interdisciplinary graduate program incorporates faculty and resources from 5 NCCU colleges: Communication, Informatics, Law, Liberal Arts, and Innovation.



International Master's Program in Asia-Pacific Studies

The IMAS program provides an interdisciplinary approach, allowing candidates to conduct original research and dig deeper into the Asia-Pacific region.



International Master in Business Administration

Taiwan's first English MBA dually accredited by AACSB and EQUIS which focuses on Asia-Pacific business dynamics and cross-cultural understanding.



International Master's Program in International Communication Studies

Focus on cross-cultural communication studies with an additional emphasis on the Asia-Pacific area.



International Doctoral Program in Asia-Pacific Studies

Emphasizes providing practical research tools and foundational courses which allow candidates to engage in high-quality, original research for delving deeper into the complexities of the Asia-Pacific region.

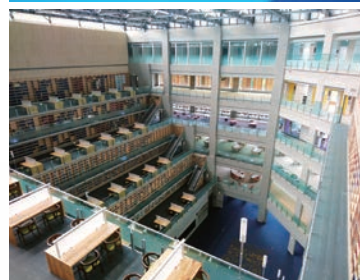

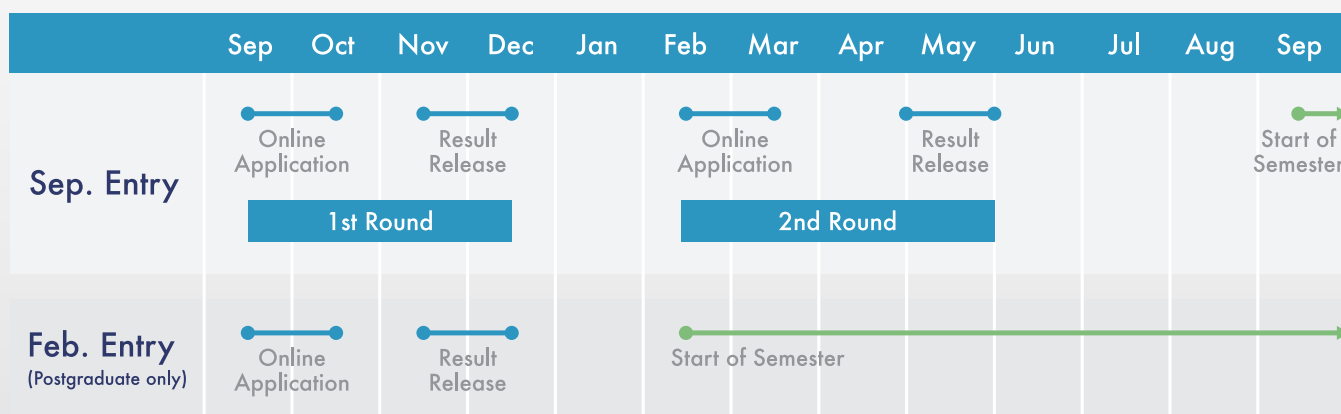

I Modules of Cooperation

Option A

NCCU develops the course curriculum and language courses and arranges excursions around Taiwan, tailored specifically for partner universities.

Option B

The partner university supplies the course curriculum and instructors. Concurrently, NCCU offers classroom space, provides language instruction, and organizes excursions around Taiwan upon request. Additionally, the Office of International Cooperation (OIC) at NCCU extends its support to the partner university in fostering collaborative relationships with relevant departments and colleges within NCCU.
